MEET FORMAT

This is a timed final meet for ages 12&Under.

This is a prelim/final event for 13&Over age group events (200s, 100s, 50s).

Timed Final Events for 13&Over 400Free, 400IM, 800 Free, 1500 Free.

Top 8 13&Over 400 Free & 400 IM will swim in the Finals session only.

13&Over 800 Free & 1500 Free will be MIXED Events, will swim at the end of Sunday's prelim session, and will alternate 800 Free /1500 Free Fastest to Slowest.

FACILITIES:

L.S.U Natatorium, site of the 1985 National Sports Festival. Indoor 50-meter pool at a constant depth of 7 feet with Non-Turbulent lane lines. Paragon starting blocks. Daktronics Timing System with 8-lane Daktronics electronic scoreboard. A six-lane 25-yard warm-up/warm-down pool is next to the 50-meter pool. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification in on file with USA Swimming.

FACILITY RULES

NO SMOKING IS PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA. NO GLASS CONTAINERS ON DECK.

Louisiana Swimming, Inc. - Alcohol Policy

Alcoholic beverages and the recognition of alcohol sponsors are prohibited in all areas of the venue. Any athlete, coach, volunteer, staff, or spectator found to be in possession of alcohol at a Louisiana Swimming, Inc. sanctioned event will be barred from the venue for the remainder of the day by the meet director and/or meet referee, or their designee.

TECHNICAL SUIT BAN for 12&Us

Per LSI Rule 210.2, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

MAAPP

All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

SAFE SPORT

The LSI Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet who is unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer's team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and all Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on deck registration available at this meet. A swimmer's age as of May 29, 2026 determines their age for the entire meet.

MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Tiger Aquatics welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit Tiger Aquatics' ability to accommodate all requests.

ENTRIES

Team entries must be received by the deadline. The entry deadline is Friday, May 22, 2026 at 11:59pm. Email entries to Rocky Smith,

rocky@swimtaq.net. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet, Friday, May 29) will determine their age for the entire meet. Swimmers will be entered on a first-come-first-served basis, due to athlete number limitations. Meet management has the right to limit the number of athletes in order to comply with Louisiana Swimming, Inc.'s four-hour rule. Meet Management has the right to adjust warmup and meet start times prior to the meet. Meet management reserves the right to reassign events/age groups to different courses. The order of events shall not be changed, but at the discretion of the meet management, breaks may be added.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Swimmers may swim a maximum of 12 individual events; 3 per session (P/F)

or 4 per session (Timed Finals).

ENTRY DEADLINES

Entries must be received by Friday, May 22. Email entries to Rocky Smith, rocky@swimtaq.net Scratches and adjustments will be allowed prior to the 1st day of the meet.

SEEDING The conforming time standard for this meet is long course meters.

Swimmers will be seeded and swim slowest to fastest. Distance events

will be seeded fastest to slowest.

There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block. **SCRATCHES**

> Swimmers who NO SHOW a finals event will be penalized. The penalty is disqualified from their next event. Swimmers will not be kicked out of the

meet for missing a finals event.

SCORING &

AWARDS This is a scored event for 12&Unders only. There will be high point awards

given for 11-12 Girls & Boys and 10&Under Girls & Boys. No ribbons will be

given at this meet.

RESULTS Meet results will be live on Meet Mobile throughout the meet. Meet

results will also be posted on swimtag.com at the conclusion of the meet.

COACHES & OFFICIALS

All coaches & officials on deck MUST be registered and certified with USA Swimming.

Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. Other Meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion (listed in the Deadline and Meeting

Summary).

OFFICIALS/ TIMERS/

VOLUNTEER

There will be a need for officials. Tiger Aquatics welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Certification will be verified by Meet Referee the day before the meet / session. There will be an officials' meeting at each meet session. A virtual meeting may be held prior to the meet / session at the referee's discretion, and all assigned officials are strongly encouraged to complete and individual personal review of applicable USAS rules for their assigned position prior to the meet. Officials should report to their assigned position 10 minutes before session start, and bring a mask,

your personal water bottle, and a writing utensil.

HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS

Concessions will be sold at the meet. Hospitality will be available for coaches and officials.

WARM-UP

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshal will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries.

WAIVER/RELEASE

As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and Louisiana Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet. Tiger Aquatics, Louisiana Swimming, Inc., and USA Swimming, Inc., their agents, employees, and coaches shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of illness or injury to anyone during the conduct of this meet. You acknowledge that by entering this meet, you are granting permission for the names of any or all of your team's swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych Sheets, Meet Results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet.

IMAGE RELEASE

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club or LSI website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast.
