- *July 24* - Deadline to submit SAT funds towards award totals.
- Auction items for fundraising credits

This will NOT appear on the SAT event website on your individual fundraising pages but it will be added to totals that show on the Leaderboard.

- Team Suit Orders through DJ Sports online (Arena or Dolphin- use sort menu on left).
 - Not required for Novice, 8 & U or AG. There is a sizing kit available at the Info Booth to check sizes before order. Wear a black Crawfish cap at the meets!

 - There is a sizing booth at the Info Booth that you can use to check sizes before ordering!
 - Training Equipment:

Fundraising Policy

Fundraising invoices have been suspended at this time.

Fundraising obligations allow flexibility for families and a lower monthly dues amount, which is reviewed annually by our staff. ***There is a 6 month grace period for new members before fundraising obligation begins.*

Withdraw from Program/ Pause Membership

Monthly enrollment groups can be cancelled with completion of this form, by the 25th of the month prior to your "drop month". Please note that Novice division groups are seasonal, not monthly, and swimmers are not automatically renewed season to season. Additionally, swimmers that joined 8 & U or Age Group for the Summer season will not be automatically renewed in the Fall and will require re-enrollment to continue (therefore an end of Summer "drop" is not required).
