# Speedo Sectional Championships Highlights

We took a team of 23 athletes to Austin, Texas for Sectionals. The team had 19 swimmers in finals on Thursday with 20 swims. It was the most we have ever had compete in one finals session at these championships! The second day we had 14 more finals swims and then on Saturday, the last day we competed the team had 17 finals swims. It was our most ever collectively for the weekend! Every athlete earned a second swim during the weekend which is a first for our team. Not many other teams in the meet with the number of athletes that we have can say that this year at this meet. They finished in 9th place with 199 points despite not contesting relays or competing on Sunday in full and focused preparations to come back to prepare for the Senior State Championships.
