## Facilities & Timing System

LSU Natatorium, site of the 1985 National Sports Festival, home of LSU Swimming and Diving, home of Tiger Aquatics. Indoor 50-meter pool of constant depth of 7 feet with 8 non-turbulent lane lines, Paddock starting blocks, Daktronics Timing System with 16 lane Daktronics electronic scoreboard.

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. The competitive course has been certified in accordance with USA Swimming Technical Rule 104.2.2C(4).

## **Rules, Regulations and General Information**

- 1. Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet.
- 2. At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision.
- 3. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- 4. All meet directors, referees, starters, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity must be members of USA Swimming.
- 5. All coaches and officials MUST constantly display their current USA Swimming credential or be prepared to present their USA Swimming ID card as proof of their registration to the Meet Director or designee at any time. The meet referee reserves the right to ask for coach credential display and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current.
- 6. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.
- 7. No entrant will be permitted to compete; unless the entrant is a member of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302. This meet is open to 2019 USA Swimming registered swimmers 8 years of age and younger.

- 8. Age as of July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019 determines the swimmer's age for the meet.
- 9. All events will be timed finals.
- 10. Swimmers may enter 4 individual events and 2 relay events.
- 11. Swimmers with a disability as described in the USA Swimming Technical Rules, Article 105, shall be permitted to enter any meet sanctioned by Louisiana Swimming.
- 12. The locker room areas and shower facilities will be restricted to use for restrooms, changing area and bathing only. No horseplay, eating or "hanging out" in this area.
- 13. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not allowed.

14. It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Louisiana Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

#### Warm-up & Procedures

Lane assignments for warm-up sessions will be posted prior to Saturday's meet. There will be three 20 minute warm up sessions. USA Swimming rules require that all warm-ups must be closely supervised by a certified USA Swimming coach or team representative.

#### Timing Assignments

Each team will provide timers in proportion to meet entries in a session. Timers will report 10 minutes prior to the start of each the session.

## <u>Clerk of Course</u>

One Coach from each team must work the clerk of course to ensure the meet runs smoothly, <u>All other spectators WILL NOT BE ALLOWED in the Clerk of Course area.</u>

## <u>Awards</u>

**Top 3 (1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>RD</sup>) finishers in each event will receive medals**. 4<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> finishers in each event will receive ribbons.

High point awards will be awarded to the top male and female point scorers in the 6 & under, 7 year old and 8 year old age groups.

Team trophies will be presented to the top 3 teams based on combined male and female points, for individual and relay events.
