

Parking Info from the Meet Host

1. Please be mindful that Friday school is in session at LSU. There is currently **NO RESERVED** parking available for the meet since this is not an LSU function on Friday. Parking in any reserved spot is at your own risk. Tiger Aquatics is working with the athletic department in hopes that the grass lot in front of the Nat can be used but that will be weather dependent. The lot was fairly saturated over the past couple weeks due to the high volume of rain but has started to dry out. Our best hope is that we have minimal to no heavy rain over the next 72 hours and we have that lot on Friday AM. Our next best option would be to find any open spots in the gravel lot behind the Natatorium but there is **NOT** parking for 500 back there
2. For Friday AM we **HIGHLY** encourage car pools, shuttles and even ride services to the pool. With over 500 participants in the meet and school in session there will be minimal areas for parking (see #1) In past years, this was not an issue in hosting but with the format change it opens us to having conflict on Friday AM. There is guest parking on campus available all the way on the other side. Union Square Village (behind Barnes and Noble) and the Ag Center Lot.
3. The side lot between the Nat and tennis courts will be reserved on Friday for beach volleyball at roughly Noon. Again, if you park in that area, it is at your own risk as cars may get towed if unauthorized to park there.
3. There is a gymnastics meet Friday night. It is their last home meet and you can expect 12,000 people in attendance. They park....everywhere.
4. Again, with over 500 participants in the meet and running out of one pool there will be a significant number of people in attendance at the meet. We ask that that only pertinent staff/members of programs as to not overcrowd the facility. We will be working on keeping the area behind the blocks in the main pool **CLEAR** (timers, swimmers, officials only). We ask that this information be shared with your programs.
