

Role of the Marshal

(Reference Article 102.19 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations):

- Wear identifying attire. (Louisiana Swimming will provide Marshall vest- these need to be turned at the end of your shift)
- Enforce warm up procedures. A copy will be provided to you at the beginning of your shift and will be posted around the pool.
- No swimmers are allowed to be in the teaching/therapy pool at any time.
- Maintain order in the venue to ensure safety.
- Warn or order to cease and desist any unsafe activities in the swimming venue.
- Report to the Referee any unsafe manner or use of profane or abusive language or those whose actions are disrupting the orderly conduct of the meet.
- NO Coaches, Spectators, or Officials are allowed in the athlete restrooms at any time! If you see someone entering them, please advise them not to enter and report to the referee if you need to.
- Monitor use of cameras, video devices, etc. These can NEVER be used behind the block by ANYONE.
- Make sure there are no spectators on the “working deck”. Spectators are only allowed in the spectator area and by Fine Designs or Concession Area. Ask any adult without a wristband to return to the spectator area.
